Now, being the Alma Mater of thousands of capable Indian citizens, Durgapur Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar (DICV) public High School welcomes its future students to take the benefit of its academic training regimen for XI and XII standard in which it excelled over the decades and be a part of its history in course of time.

THE NEW SYLLABUS :

The west Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education has adapted the totally revised syllabus from the academic session 2013-2004. The syllabus being at par with the all India programs for the +2 students, will be an added advantage to the H. s. council students as this council is already in a favorable position in the assessment of the first quartile of the H.S. examinees in comparison with the All India Board. So the aspirants for the Engineering and Medical courses through All India Examination from west Bengal HS council will been aligned with the All India admission requirements Moreover no separate assessment will be required for admission to colleges outside West Bengal (in Delhi, Maharastra, Karnatak, Gujarat.)

ADMISSION:

The Institution will follow the guidelines of west Bengal council of Higher secondary Education regarding admission in (class-XI) from any recognized All India Board, like I.C.S.E., C.B.S.E. or from any recognized state boards, can apply for admission.(please see the notified list of the approved secondary Boards). All admission will be initially provisional, subject to verification of the authenticity of the submission documents like mark-sheets of the qualifying examination etc. submitted at the time of admission.

Since the seats are limited, all applicants cannot admitted, merit being the main criterion. The Institution authority reserves the right of admission of a candidate or refusing it. Candidates passing from C.B.S.E internal school examination or through Patrachar Vidyalaya, I.C.S.E commerce are NOT eligible to get admission in H. S. courses under West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education. Candidates who have passed the Secondary or its equivalent Examination under the open school system are NOT eligible for admission under this Council. Candidates who have passed the Secondary Examination from the approved boards are eligible for admission in Class XI on the basis of equivalence with the Madhyamik Pariksha conducted by West Bengal Board of Secondary Education. West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education reserves the right equivalence. Such scrutiny shall be made on (a) Regular Course of studies (b) Subject package.
